If you want to improve your knowledge of the French language and the length of your stay permits, you can apply to one of the specialist organisations in Lyon offering language training for foreigners. Here too it is a good idea to enrol before arrival in France: doing so will allow you to fit your language classes into your overall timetable.

There are many private and public centres for the teaching of French as a foreign language. Fees vary from one establishment to another and according to the length of the course. Chambers of Commerce (CCI), the universities, the Alliance Française and private language schools offer courses leading to qualifications recognised by the Ministry for Youth, Education and Research.

The best tactic is to learn French before leaving, then hone your skills once in France. There are French institutes and branches of the Alliance Française in most countries, offering courses at all levels and preparation for diplomas recognised in France. The French Embassy can provide the necessary addresses.

### THE CITY'S MAIN SPORTS VENUES

Well known for its hosting of World Cup football matches in 1998, the stadium has room for 40,000 spectators for football and rugby events. Champion League matches are played here – featuring, of course, local team Olympique Lyonnais (OL), French champions for the last two years.
